



ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIPS - YEAR 7, 2018

The Endeavour Scholarships are available annually to four boys of Maori or Pasifika descent.

Candidates must have completed Year 6 at the end of 2017 and be ready to enter Year 7 in 2018.

The Endeavour Scholarship Programme is designed for students who display leadership potential and have all round ability. Applicants of this scholarship sit an entrance test and go through an interview process, which takes into account the overall ability of the candidate, his participation in cultural, sporting and community activities, as well as his school record.

All candidates will be required to be at King's School on <u>Tuesday</u>, 22nd <u>August</u> between **8.50** am and **2.30** pm to sit General Mathematic and Reading tests and take part in sporting initiatives and one-on-one discussions. Parents are invited to attend Chapel and tour the School but will leave after this tour and return to collect their sons at 2.30 pm. After the application has been received by the school an explanatory letter outlining the day will be sent to applicants' families.

Once results are compiled which takes up to two weeks, a shortlist of boys will be contacted and asked to attend an interview together with their parents. The interview date will be advised. Families of successful boys will be required to complete a confidential financial information form. Unsuccessful candidates will be advised in writing at this time.

This is a financial scholarship that includes tuition fees, uniform allowance and other expenses. The level of parental contribution will be independently assessed and based on the current financial position of the family.

When submitting your application, a passport-sized photograph must be enclosed along with copy of the candidate's most recent school report and a **copy** of his birth certificate. In addition, you will need to ask the Principal of your son's present school to complete a "Confidential Report Form" to be returned by his school to Kirsty Higgs, King's School, Private Bag 28914, Remuera, Auckland 1541 at their earliest convenience.
