



ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIPS - YEAR 7, 2020

Applications Close – Friday 10 May 2019

The Endeavour Scholarships are available annually to four boys of Maori or Pasifika descent.

Candidates must have completed Year 6 at the end of 2019 and be ready to enter Year 7 in 2020.

The Endeavour Scholarship Programme is designed for students who display leadership potential and have all round ability. Applicants of this scholarship sit an entrance test and go through an interview process which takes into account the overall ability of the candidate, his participation in cultural, sporting and community activities, as well as his school record.

All candidates will be required to be at King's School on **Tuesday, 14 May** between **8.50 am and 2.30 pm** to sit General Mathematics and Reading tests and take part in sporting activities and one-on-one discussions.

Once results are compiled which takes up to three weeks, a shortlist of boys will be contacted and asked to attend an interview together with their parents. The interview date will be advised at that time. Unsuccessful candidates will be advised in writing at this time.

This is a financial scholarship that includes tuition fees, uniform allowance and other expenses. The level of parental contribution will be independently assessed and based on the current financial position of the family.

When submitting your application, a passport-sized photograph must be enclosed along with a copy of the candidate's most recent school report and a **copy** of his birth certificate.

In addition, you will need to ask the Principal of your son's current school to complete the "Confidential Schools Report". This should be returned directly to the Admissions Manager, King's School, Private Bag 28914, Remuera, Auckland 1541 or emailed to a.lonsdale@kings.school.nz
