



## **ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIPS - YEAR 7, 2021**

## Applications Close – Friday 12 June, 2020

The Endeavour Scholarships are available annually to four boys of Maori or Pasifika descent, and are tenable for 7 years – Years 7 and 8 at King's School, followed by Years 9 to 13 at King's College. The Endeavour Scholarship is a financial scholarship that includes tuition fees, uniform allowance and other school-related expenses. The level of parental contribution will be independently assessed, and will be based on the current financial position of the family.

Candidates must have completed Year 6 at the end of 2020, and be ready to enter Year 7 in 2021.

The Endeavour Scholarship Programme is designed for students who are actively involved in their culture, display leadership potential and have all-round ability. Applicants for this scholarship will sit entrance testing and go through an interview process which takes into account the overall ability of the student, his participation in cultural, sporting and community activities, as well as his school record.

As part of the application process, all applicants will be required to sit General Mathematics and Reading tests, take part in sporting activities and one-on-one discussions.

These will be held at <u>King's School, 258 Remuera Road</u>, on <u>Monday, 22 June</u> from 8.50 am to 2.30 pm and <u>Wednesday, 24 June</u> from 8.50 am to 2.30 pm. Applicants will only be required to attend <u>one</u> of these testing dates. You will be contacted with the date your son is invited to attend.

Once results are compiled, a shortlist of boys will be contacted and invited to attend an interview at King's School together with their parents, in Term 3, 2020. Unsuccessful candidates will be advised in writing at this time. Please be aware that it can take up to three weeks for King's School to compile and analyse all results.

When submitting your application, please enclose a recent passport-sized photograph of the applicant, along with a **copy** of his most recent school report and a **copy** of his birth certificate.

In addition, you will need to ask the Principal of your son's current school to complete the "Confidential Schools Report".
