



ENDEAVOUR SCHOLARSHIPS For Entry to Year 7, 2027

Applications Close Thursday 30 April 2026

King's School Endeavour Scholarships are available annually to four boys of Māori or Pasifika descent, who are actively involved in their culture, can demonstrate academic achievement and display all-round ability. Applicants must hold NZ Citizenship or NZ Residency.

The Endeavour Scholarship is tenable for **seven years of education: Years 7 to 8 at King's School followed by Years 9 – 13 at King's College.** Four Endeavour Scholarships are awarded each year.

This is a financial aide scholarship which includes tuition fees, uniform allowance and other school-related expenses. (Please note King's College Boarding Fees are not included in the Scholarship).

The level of parental contribution is independently assessed, and based on the current financial position of the family.

All applicants will be required to attend the Endeavour Scholarship Assessment Day at **King's School on Tuesday 5 May 2026, from 9.00am – 2.15pm.**

The applicant will sit examinations in Literacy, Mathematics and Reasoning, take part in sporting activities and have a one-on-one discussion with our Headmaster. Each assessment is 45 minutes long, and all questions are multiple choice.

If the applicant requires the support of a reader/writer for these assessments, King's School can provide one on request.

Shortlisted applicants and their parents will be invited to attend an interview at King's School, in Term 3, 2026. Unsuccessful candidates will be advised in writing at this time.

When submitting the application, please include the following documents:

- completed application form
- a recent photograph of the applicant (head and shoulders)
- a copy of the applicant's most recent school report,
- a copy of any Educational Psychologists Assessments or other Specialist Assessments (eg Speech Therapist / Occupational Therapist / Giftedness Assessment),
- a copy of his NZ birth certificate or NZ passport or NZ Residency permit,
- applicant's one-page personal statement.

Please arrange for your son's current school to complete the "Confidential School's Report".
