



John Henley Music Scholarship

For Entry to Year 7, 2027

Applications Close 5.00pm Wednesday 18 February 2026

We are now inviting applications for the King's School Foundation John Henley Music Scholarship, for entry to King's School in Year 7, 2027. This scholarship is valued up to 50% of tuition fees per annum, tenable for Years 7 and 8 at King's School.

The John Henley Music Scholarship is open to boys who are due to enter Year 7 in 2027, who are playing an instrument at Grade 5 or above.

Shortlisted applicants will be asked to attend an in-person audition with our Director of Performing Arts, Mrs Kirsten Scouller. During the in-person audition, shortlisted applicants will be required to play their chosen piece, and may also be tested on sight-reading and music theory.

When submitting an application, you will be asked to provide :

- the completed Application Form
- an audition video, showcasing applicant performing their strongest instrument
 - Videos should be no longer than 4 minutes long. Editing accordingly is acceptable. Applicants must introduce themselves and the name and composer of their piece at the beginning of the audition video.
- a copy of the applicant's highest Grade Certificate/s and/or List of Musical Achievements
- a letter of recommendation from applicant's current music tutor/s
- a copy of the applicant's 2025 end-of-year School Report
- a recent photograph of the applicant (head and shoulders)
- a copy of applicant's NZ Birth Certificate or NZ Passport, NZ Residency or Domestic Student Visa
